## Black Grouper

## Fun Facts:

- Similar to most groupers, these fish start out as females, and then at a certain age and size, become males.
- ▼ The fish are characterized by small eyes over a protruding lower jaw with an olive gray color, dark blotches and bronze hexagonal shapes on its head and sides. They can grow to up to 52 inches long and weigh up to 180 lbs.

## Cooking:

- ∀ This type of fish has a very mild flavor (somewhere in between seabass and halibut)
- ∀ They have a light, sweet taste and large, chunky flakes, almost like lobster or crab.
- Black grouper is very easy to prepare (bake, broil, fry, grill or steam)
- ⊙ Grouper is considered a good source of vitamin B6, vitamin B12, phosphorus, potassium, and selenium.
